ICT class was taken by Dr. Rubi Borah, Associate professor of Assamese Department



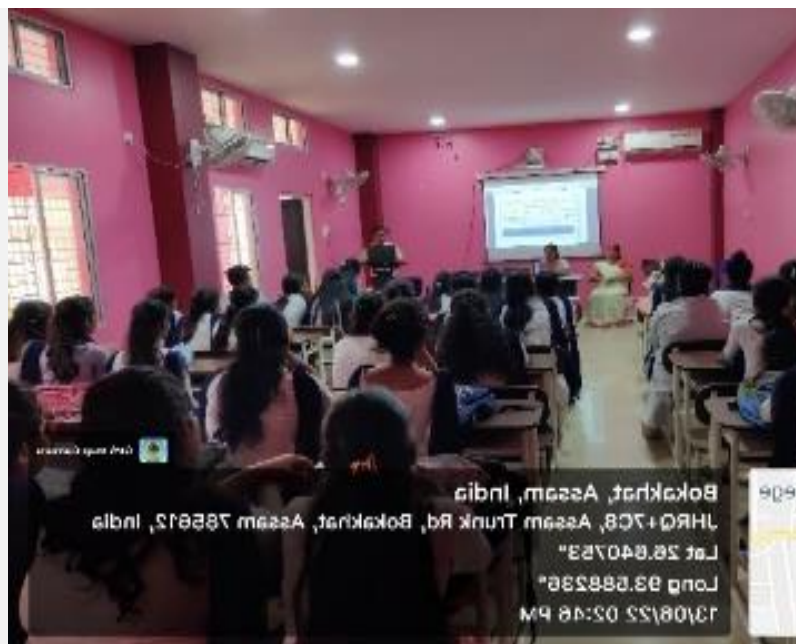

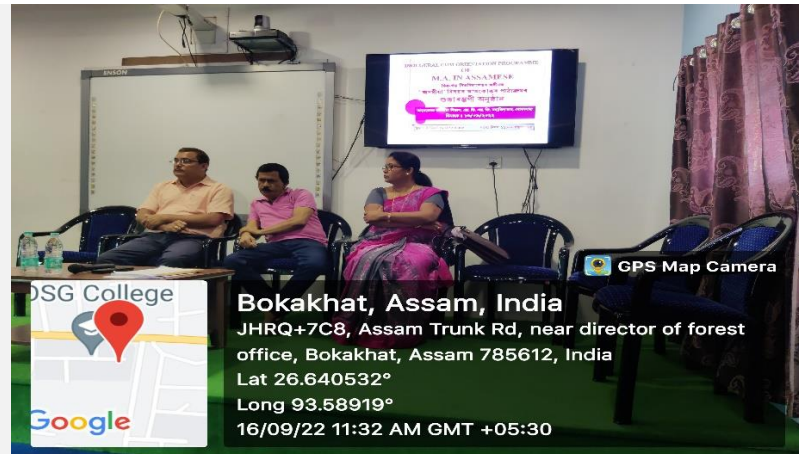
