About National Service Scheme (NSS) Units of JDSG College:

The National Service Scheme (NSS) sponsored by the Ministry of Youth Affairs and Sports has been in operation in JDSG College since 1973. There are at present 2 units of national service scheme. The basic objectives of the NSS are to arouse and enrich the social consciousness of students. The units have been organizing activities related to social problems widely. Specific programs relates to:

a) Environment: plantation activities, cleanliness drives, plastic elimination campaign are conducted as well as workshop and seminars to create awareness.

b) Wildlife Protection: As the college is adjacent to the World Heritage site Kaziranga National park, NSS considers it a social responsibility to extend help towards protection of wildlife. With this view various programs like rescue and rehabilitation of wild animals during floods, cleanliness drives at animal corridors, participation in census of animals and birds are conducted along with workshop and seminars to create awareness.

c) Observation of important events:

Important events like republic Day Independence Day, Martyrs day, Gandhi Jayanti, International Day of yoga are regularly held along with other programs like covid-19 awareness, vaccination programs etc.

d) Special camp: Special camps of a duration of one week is being regularly held at adopted villages of Sonargaon, Dergoyapam, Nowgayapam and kuruabahi gaon to create awareness on rural life among the students .NSS volunteers also participate in the state as well as regional mega camps ,blood donation camps etc.

NSS ACTIVITIES DURING 2019-2020

1. A Sensitization programme on World No Tobacco Day:

It was observed by NSS Unit I & II on 31/05/19. The programme was anchored by Prasanta Saikia, P.O. NSS Unit II. Senior program officer Prasanta Kr. Phukan elaborated upon the harmful effects of consuming tobacco products. Dr. Jayanta Gogoi Principal of the college explained the impact of use of tobacco on human health as well as the society. Prof. Santisaya Baruah also dealt on the severe consequences of use of tobacco especially on women and children. Rituraj Baruah from the students has stated that they are benefited by the program and would try to make their colleagues aware on the issue. A pledge was also taken on this occasion.



2. Observation of World Environment Day:

An awareness programme was organized by NSS Unit – I & II in the college campus on the occasion of World Environment Day on 5th June, 2019. Prasanta Saikia anchored the programme. Senior P.O. Prasanta Kr. Phukan delivered a speech where he stated that plantation of more trees can only save the Earth from water, air and soil pollution. Prof. Rashna Paddi said that we should make aware ourselves first and then to make aware others on environment pollution. Dr. Bijoy Sarmah stated the examples of environmental awareness especially in developed countries. Prof. Sasanka Dhawal Saikia and Prof. Rubi Bora are also present in the programme. Altogether 100 saplings are planted in the college and Kalyanpur Secondary School campus.



3. Training Programme on Yoga:

Four days training program on 'Yoga' held at Yoga centre from 17th to 20th June, 2019, under the teachings of Nishant Agarwalla- Yoga Teacher. Prashanta Kr. Phukan and Prasanta Saikia are present in the training program. After the program volunteer were provided with light refreshment.

It was inaugurated by Dr. Jayanta Gogoi, Principal on 21st June, 2019. In his inaugural speech, he emphasized on physical exercise and Yoga to control human mind and body. 11. FIT INDIA Plogging Run:

'FIT INDIA Plogging Run' was organized by NSS unit –I & II of JDSG college Bokakhat to commemorate the 150th birth Anniversary of Mahatma Gandhi on 2nd Oct,2019. The programme was inaugurated by Prashanta Kr. Phukan P.O. Unit-I. In his inaugural speech he explained the need of physical fitness and plastic free environment to the volunteers.
