


NSS ACTIVITIES DURING 2020-2021:

1. International Day of Yoga:

An online awareness programme was held on 21st June, 2020 the occasion of International Day of Yoga. The programme was inaugurated by Dr. Jayanta Gogoi, Principal of J.D.S.G College. In his inaugural speech, he outlined the significance of Yoga on human life especially in the present Covid 19 pandemic. Nishant Agarwalla, Yoga Instructor, of Patanjali yoga pith explained the theoretical aspect of yoga. He highlighted the importance of regular practice of yoga exercises to get beneficial result. Srimanta Madhab Bora, librarian and Sanat Kr. Phukan, yoga practiser, also expressed their views on the subject.
