


Special Class on Telephone and Interview Skills conducted at JDSG College Bokakhat 2023

Report on Educational Survey to Khotiakholi, Bokakhat

INTRODUCTION:

An in-depth survey was carried out by the students of 6th Semester (Honours) CBCS of the Education Department for the fulfillment of their course work in relation with their paper DSEED 604 (PROJECT REPORT) in the village of Khotiakholi, located in the Bokakhat region in Golaghat district, Assam, on 23.3.2024. The students were supervised by the faculty members of the Education department J.D.S.G college, Bokakhat

The survey was conducted under the supervision of the faculty members Mrs. Ruli Khanikar, Mrs. Pranati Talukdar, Mr. Chandrakanta Das, Mrs. Monjumoni Neog. The purpose of the survey was to understand and analyze the socio-economic issues faced by the residents of the area. The total students of 6th semester were 24 and they were divided into 4 groups. This report presents the findings, insights based on the survey data collected through interviews, focus group discussions, and observations.

OBJECTIVE OF THE SURVEY:

The survey aimed to identify socio-economic challenges faced by villagers, their impact on education, health, and livelihood, and provide recommendations for addressing these issues, using 40 households and structured questionnaires, semi-structured interviews, and participatory observation techniques.

FINDINGS:

Economic challenges like dependency on agriculture, unemployment, and a lack of financial institutions are among the economic issues that cause people to turn to unofficial moneylenders and migrate to neighboring towns. The village faces educational issues, including inadequate school infrastructure, high dropout rates, limited parental awareness, and limited healthcare access. Additionally, poor access to clean drinking water leads to waterborne diseases like diarrhea and cholera. Malnutrition, gender inequality, substance abuse, and cultural conflicts are prevalent issues affecting children and women, particularly pregnant mothers, affecting economic and social behavior, and posing challenges for modern education and health.

CONCLUSION:

The survey highlighted that while Khotiakholi has immense potential for growth, the village faces several socio-economic challenges that hinder its progress. By addressing these issues collectively through government, NGOs, and community participation, significant improvements can be achieved. The students of the 6th Semester Education Department gained valuable insights and experiences through this field study, which can contribute to their understanding of real-world challenges.

Report on Day-long workshop on Solid Waste Management at JDSG College



The workshop was concluded after taking the feedback from participants and with vote of thanks. Some of the photographs are presented below,


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



- The importance of sanitation and hygiene for public health.

The Eco Club of JDSG College, Bokakhat has organized a one day workshop on vermicomposting on 14th May 2024, with the support of Assam Science Technology and Environment council, under the aegis of Ministry of Environment, Forests and Climate, Government of India.

The workshop was inaugurated by Dr. Jayanta Gogoi, Honorable Principal of the college. He stated about the need for vermicomposting in the contemporary time and also highlighted the commercial viability of the same in the region. He also emphasised on the various initiatives taken by the Agro-Cell of J.D.S.G. College in the areas of vermicomposting. He also spoke on the different methods of preparation of vermicomposting and various associated issues.

Resource person for the first technical session, Dr. Bijoy Sarmah, Head Department of History, as well as coordinator, agro-cell of the college in his presentation stressed on Vermicomposting process and use of earthworms to convert organic waste into compost. Besides he also stressed on microbial activity which plays a crucial in the process. Importance of recycling organic waste and improvement in the soil health by the vermicomposting is also discussed in the presentation.

After the first technical session, the students were taken for hands on training in the two different vermicomposting sites maintained by the agro cell of J.D.S.G College within the college premises.

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

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
