












What do you think about the balance between theory and practical application of your curriculum





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
Do you often visit the department /college libray







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How do you find the teaching environment of the department?










Library reading environment – Very good = 32.4%






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How would you rate the classroom facilities?




  
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Are the sports facilities at the college sufficient?








Course delivery the faculty members in the class


Usage of teaching aids and ICT in the class by faculty to facilitate teaching




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Most of the students are satisfied with the assessment process. 23.1% rate the process as excellent.


Timely announcement of examination results, display of marks, etc.)


