Best Practice 1:

AGRIPRENEURSHIP FOR RESOURCE MOBILIZATION

Objectives:

- To optimise the utilisation of available land areas within the campus.
- To impart the knowledge of sustainable farming and cultivation to the students.
- To generate a considerable amount of additional income from the sale of agricultural and vermicompost products.
- To promote self-employability skills among the students through agricultural and allied farming practices.
- To achieve a green and sustainable campus.

The Context:

Jogananda Deva Satradhikar Gowsami (JDSG) College, is situated in a beautiful natural ambience by the side of N.H. 37, in the close vicinity of the Kaziranga National Park-the world heritage site. The college has a predominantly rural feeding area. The students are mostly from economically deprived background. The practice aims to inculcate the required skill, knowledge and collective impetus for economic and financial inclusivity of the students. Further, the College is committed to enhance its own resource mobilisation avenues.

The Practice:

The College has maintained a number of farming and cultivation projects since 2018. These include Banana Cultivation, Hybrid Napier Cultivation, Lemon plantation and Tea plantation. The college has also a functional vermicompost unit since 2019. Recently it has also initiated floral and fruits plantation within its premises.

It must be noted that the college has been successful in generating a considerable income from this agricultural produce. For which, the college has proposed to open its own outlet to streamline the marketing of some of these home-grown products.

The Context:





4. Field Visit To “Nameri No2 Bordikorai Ghat Picnic Spot” organized by Department of Economics on the date of the 9th April, 2023.

5. Field visit of B. Com 6th semester students by Department of Commerce, J.D.S.G. College


A group of B. Com 6th semester students (Management group) visited Diffloo tea factory on 11th April 2023, as a part of academia-industry interface. Objective of the visit was to provide a practical understanding of the theories of the paper “Labour and Industrial Law (DSE 601 Group-II)”. Burhan Ahmed Laskar, Senior Manager Diffloo tea garden provided a general overview of the garden and welcomed the students. The students were familiarise with plantation, plucking and production of the tea in the garden. They were also familiarised with the production process inside the factory premises by the Deputy Manager Mr. Utpal Laskar. The labour welfare officer Miss Anisha Nayak highlighted different welfare measures taken by the tea garden authority for their workers. The group of students were accompanied by Mr. Motiram Das and Dr. Bidyut Jyoti Kalita, Assistant Professor, Department of Commerce, J.D.S.G College during the visit.



6. A field study and Awareness Programme by Department of History on 10th April, 2023

Numaligarh rampart: A Historical Tour (A Field Study and Awareness Programme)


A combined field trip to the historical Numaligarh rampart was organized for the students of History (Honours) and the students enrolled with the add on course of Tourism in North-East India of J.D.S.G. College, the students of History (Honours) of Marangi Mahavidyalaya and Numaligarh Higher Secondary School on 10th April, 2023. The field survey was conducted by the three institutions in collaboration with Bokakhat Journalist Association. The primary motive behind the field trip was to raise awareness about the rampart among the students and to suggest measures for its preservation. The program began with the school song performed by the students of Numaligarh Higher Secondary School. The inaugural lecture was delivered by Principal, Numaligarh Higher Secondary School where he gave a brief description on the historical identity of the Numaligarh rampart and the works so far done by the Directorate of Archaeology, Assam for its preservation. He explained the further necessity for its preservation as the rampart is on the verge of extinction due to governmental negligence and lack of awareness among the general public. A lecture on the rampart and its history was delivered by Dr. Bijoy Sarmah, Associate Professor, Department of History, J.D.S.G. College. He also discussed about the importance of preserving the rampart for our future generation to understand our glorious past. The next lecture was given by Chiranjib Dahal and Amarjit Hazarika, Assistant Professors from the Department of History, J.D.S.G. College where both gave an historical introduction of the rampart and suggested measures for its preservation. The final lecture was given by a member of Bokakhat Journalist Association who explained the role so far played by the association towards the preservation of the rampart. He further assured the Bokakhat Journalist Association will do the needful in the near future to maintain the existence of the rampart. At last the students are asked to give their feedback on the program and the things they learned from the session to which Kuhismita Borah, a student of 6th semester History (Honours) of J.D.S.G. College gave her feedback about what she learned about the rampart from the program. After the lecture program was over the students went to physically survey the rampart along with their respective mentors from the three institutions.

Challenges and Resources Required:

1. Owing to the hectic academic schedule, it poses a considerable challenge for the students and teachers alike to initiate and complete the projects within a stipulated time frame.
2. Due to limited fund, some projects couldn't be implemented for the larger community
