Best Practice 1: AGRIPRENEURSHIP FOR RESOURCE MOBILIZATION

Objectives:

- To optimise the utilisation of available land areas within the campus.
- To impart the knowledge of sustainable farming and cultivation to the students.
- To generate a considerable amount of additional income from the sale of agricultural and vermi-compost products.
- To promote self-employability skills among the students through agricultural and allied farming practices.
- To achieve a green and sustainable campus.

The Context:

Jogananda Deva Satradhikar Gowsami (JDSG) College, is situated in a beautiful natural ambience by the side of N.H. 37, in the close vicinity of the Kaziranga National Park-the world heritage site. The college has a predominantly rural feeding area. The students are mostly from economically deprived background. The practice aims to inculcate the required skill, knowledge and collective impetus for economic and financial inclusivity of the students. Further, the College is committed to enhance its own resource mobilisation avenues.

The Practice:

The College has maintained a number of farming and cultivation projects since 2018. These include Banana Cultivation, Hybrid Napier Cultivation, Lemon plantation and Tea plantation. The college has also a functional vermicompost unit since 2019. Recently it has also initiated floral and fruits plantation within its premises.

It must be noted that the college has been successful in generating a considerable income from this agricultural produce. For which, the college has proposed to open its own outlet to streamline the marketing of some of these home-grown products.

- To engage the students of the college at community/classroom teaching programmes at the nearby schools.
- To organise donation camp/health/cleanliness drives/ blood donation camp at the community level.

The Context:

Education has never been about dissemination of bookish knowledge within the four walls of the classroom. JDSG College has always believed in this approach and through the years has endeavoured to go beyond classrooms and work at grassroot level to uplift society. It has always engaged its faculties and students in various socio-cultural activities aimed at facilitating the common populace with regards to social, environmental and gender –related issues. On 7th June, 2022 A survey was conducted by the students o BA 6th semester (honours) CBSC in connection with their paper DSEED 604 (project Report). The area selected for study was Naharjan Jugigaon of Bokakhat Sub-division in Golaghat district, Assam. The students were supervised by the faculty members of education department, J.D.S.G. college, Bokakhat. The students were divided into three groups and three topics were selected for study. The topics were distribution to each group as follows.
