


J.D.S.G. COLLEGE NCC REPORT ON INTERNATIONAL YOGA DAY

The programme ended with a vote of thanks by Lt. Mintu Tokbi (ANO NCC Boys Unit)



7 days special camp in the Paschim Kolakhowa Gaon


