The workshop was an engaging one, where students also shared their aspirations and ideas to transform their ideas into business.

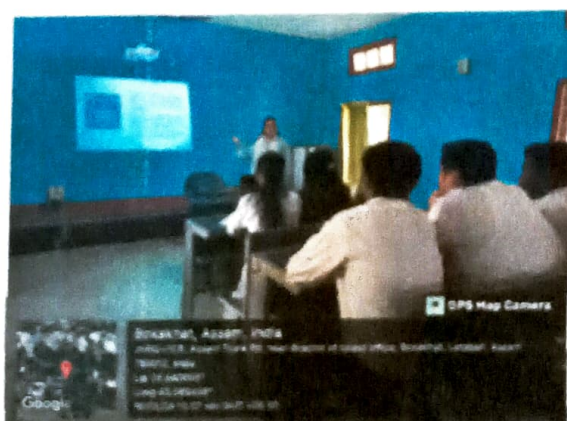
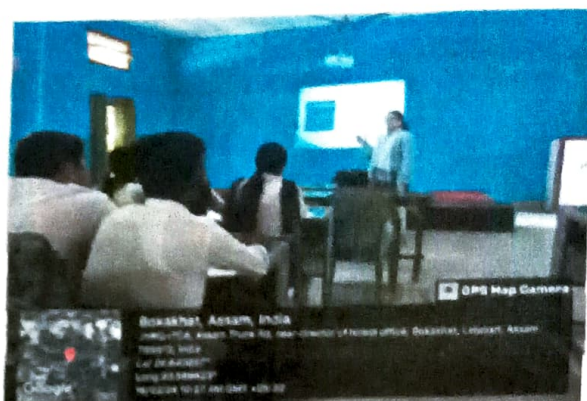
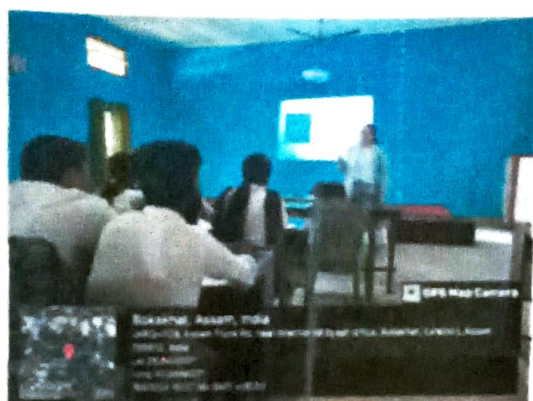
The session was attended by 50 students and 5 faculty members.
