






Outcomes:

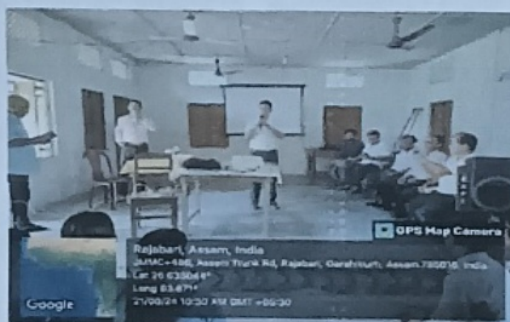
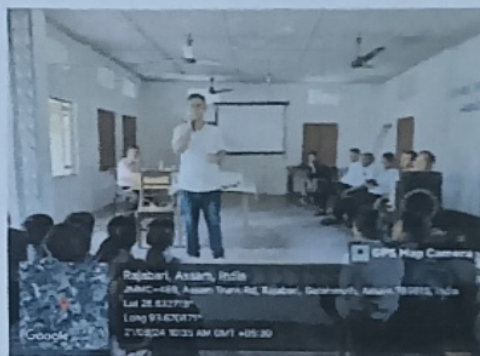
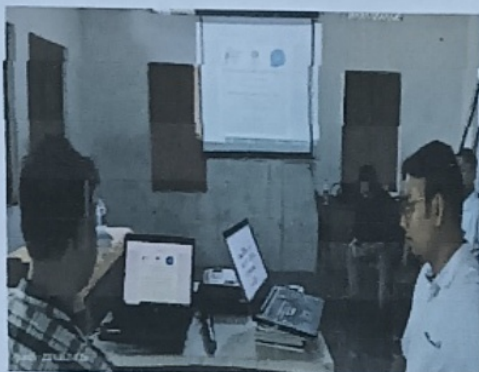
