

RECORDS OF EVENTS/PROGRAMMES ORGANISED BY DEPARTMENT OF HISTORY

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
The Department of History stands as a pillar of academic heritage, nurtured by a lineage of distinguished educators who shaped its legacy over decades. The department's roots trace back to pioneers like Ajit Borah (1964-1969), whose foundational role culminated in his retirement as Principal, and Bhola Gogoi (1970-1972), who contributed during the institution's formative years. Dr Bibha Borah, with her remarkable tenure spanning 1969 to 2006, epitomizes this tradition, retiring as Principal after earning accolades for her leadership and scholarly contributions. Longevity and dedication shine through figures such as Deben Sarmah, whose 35-years of service (1975-2010) underscores unwavering commitment, and Mrs. Deepa Saikia (1979-2016), whose 37-year tenure reflects profound institutional loyalty. The department also celebrates luminaries like Dr. Dambarudhar Nath (1976-1977), whose academic journey led him to prestigious roles as a Chaired Professor at Dibrugarh University, the First Vice-Chancellor of Cultural University of Majuli, and presently Vice-Chancellor of Auniati Satra University, Teok. Gopikananda Saikia (1988-2022), Hem Sagar Sarma (1990-1991), Jaishree Saikia (1991-1993) and Mridul Baruah (1995-2013). Currently, the department thrives under the leadership of Dr. Bijoy Sarmah (M.A. MPhil, Ph. D) who serves as the Head of the Department. The present faculty team includes: Dr. Chiranjib Dahal (MA., M.Ed., M.Phil., Ph.D.), Mr. Amarjit Hazarika (M.A), Miss Akashi Phukan (M.A., M.Phil.) and Mr. Mayuresh Borthakur (M.A.), all of whom bring their expertise and commitment to nurturing students. Additionally, Dr. Liky Deka (2020-2024) and Mr. Tarun Halder (2017-2019) who once served this institution, now have gone on to contribute their knowledge in other esteemed institutions, further extending their impact beyond this college. Moreover, special mention must be made of Mrinal Kakoty, Mrs. Monalicha Saikia (Popy), Darpan Daw and Monalisa Saikia, who worked on lien and contractual basis, nonetheless extending their impact for the development of the department and nurturing students during their desired needs. Through the dedication of these past and present faculty members, the Department of History continues to uphold its legacy of academic excellence, fostering an environment where students are empowered to excel in their chosen fields. Together, these scholars weave a tapestry of intellectual rigor, institutional pride, and timeless dedication to the study+ of history.

3. Another decision to collect an amount of 100rs from each student was taken.



Parent Teacher Meet, 2022

On 27th of June, 2022, the Department of History of JDSG College organized a parent-teacher meet to make the parents aware of the progress report of their wards. The meeting was presided over by Dr. Bijoy Sarmah, HOD Department of History, who was joined by the other faculty members of the department namely Chiranjib Dahal, Dr. Liky Deka and Amarjit Hazarika. In the meeting 14 students came along with their respective guardians.

The meeting was hosted by Chiranjib Dahal and the first interactive session was started by Dr. Bijoy Sarmah. Dr. Sarmah explained to the parents about the marks distribution pattern of the new CBCS system, about the requirement of attendance and the marking systems. He urged the parents to encourage their wards to come to college regularly and to watch out their ward's activities at home as well. The next session was taken over by Chiranjib Dahal who

explained to the parents about the credit point system that is newly introduced along with the CBCS syllabus, he further gave important ideas to the students for scoring marks in the exams. The next session was conducted by Dr. Liky Deka where she also talked about the falling grades of the students and the possible reason behind it. She further put forth ideas to improve the grades in the upcoming exams. The final session was taken over by Amarjit Hazarika where he explained to the guardians about their roles, they can take up to improve the overall development of their wards.

After the sessions were over a few of the parents expressed their views on the meeting as well as openly talked about the grievances they notice in their wards and asked for possible solution for the matter. Matters related to studying, use of mobile, attendance and lessening studying hours were some of the common issues noticed in the students as expressed by the parents.

The program was finally concluded with a lecture delivered by Dr. Jayanta Gogoi, honorable Principal JDSG College. He explained to the students about the importance of maintaining discipline within the college boundaries. He took up an initiative in the meeting to provide funding to the economically backward students by giving them free residing facility in the college hostel. He further explained to the students about the importance of visiting the library. The meeting came to an end after assurances made from both the parents and the teachers regarding the joint efforts they are going to make for the all round development of the students.


