### **PROCEEDING OF THE PROGRAMME**

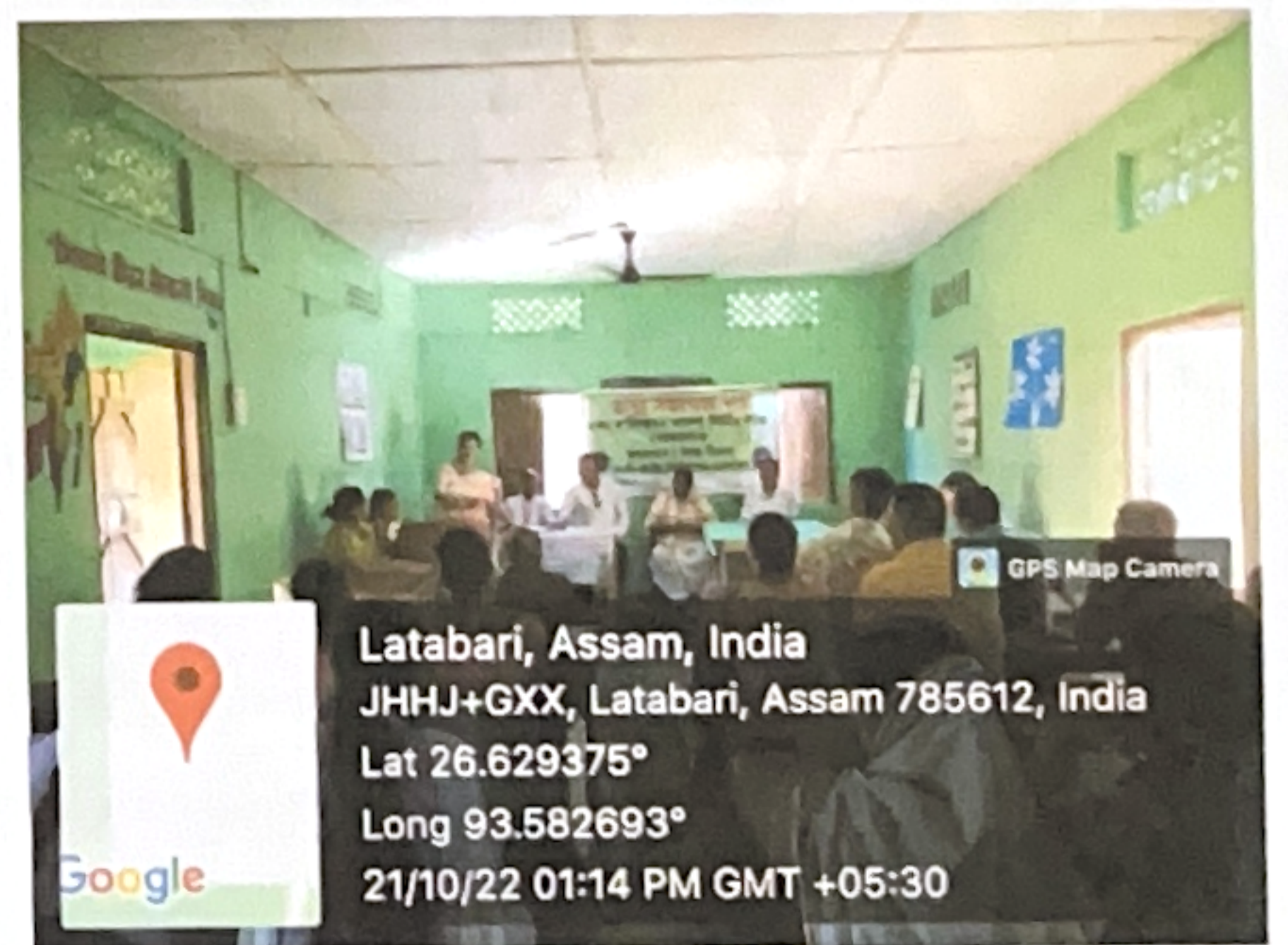
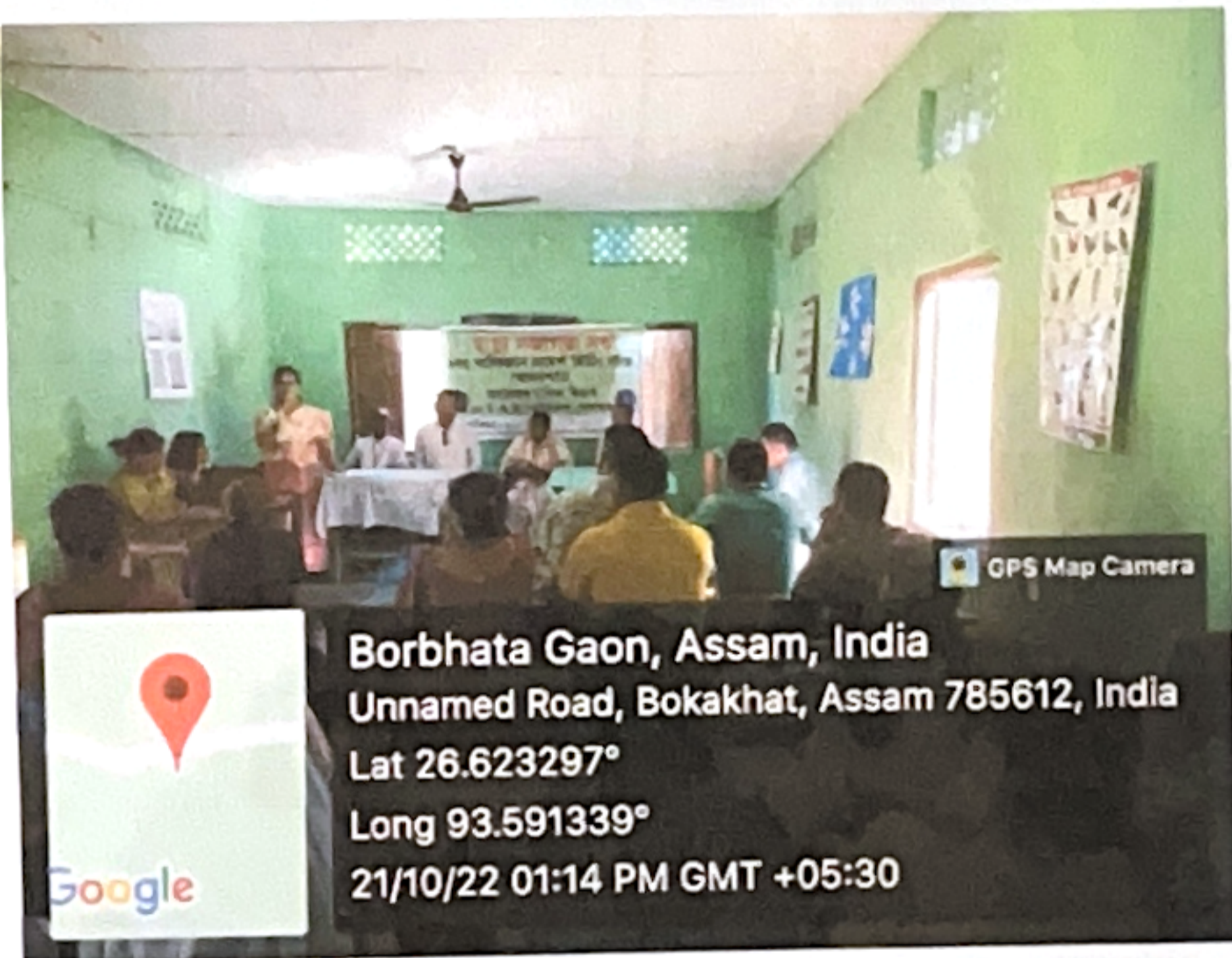
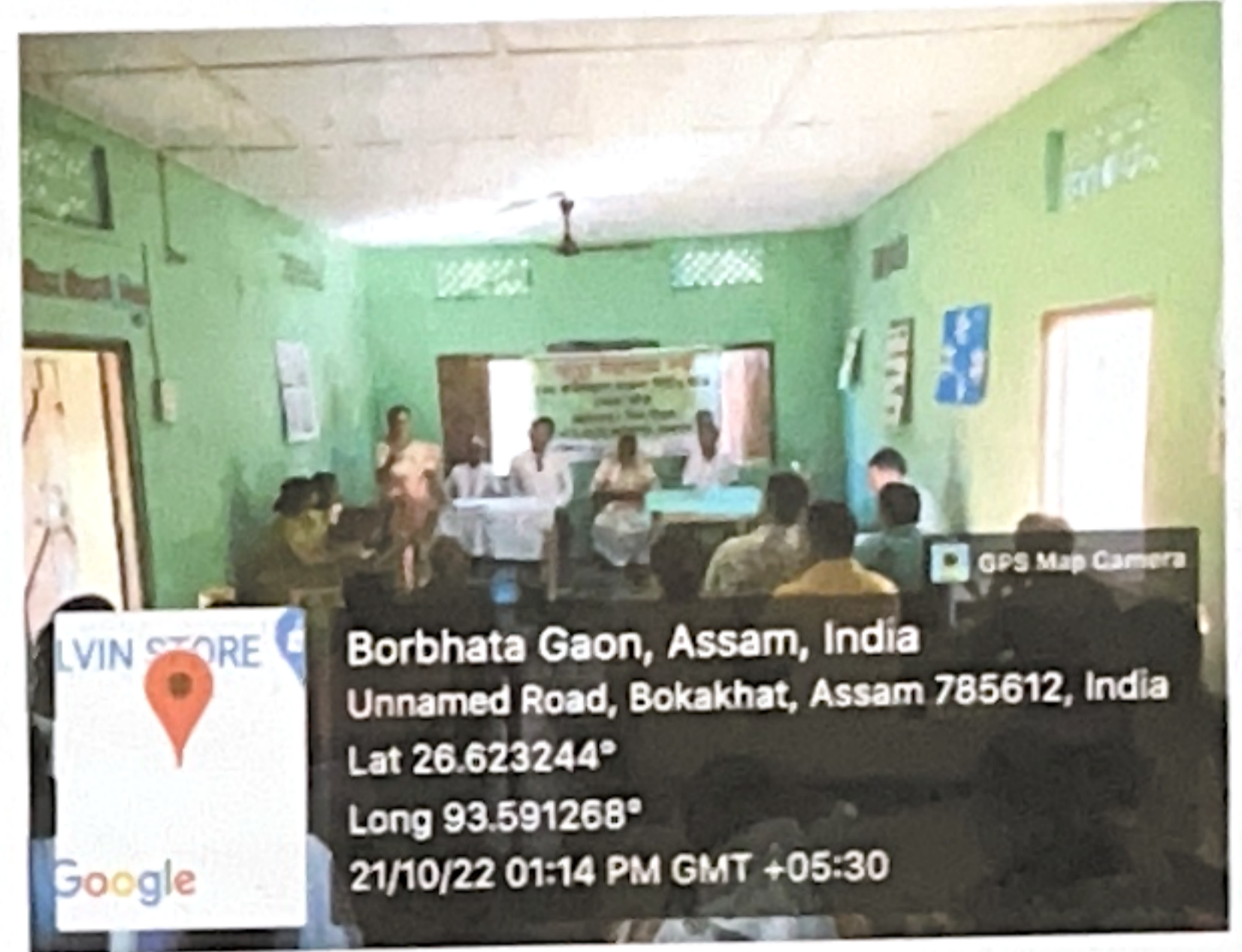
