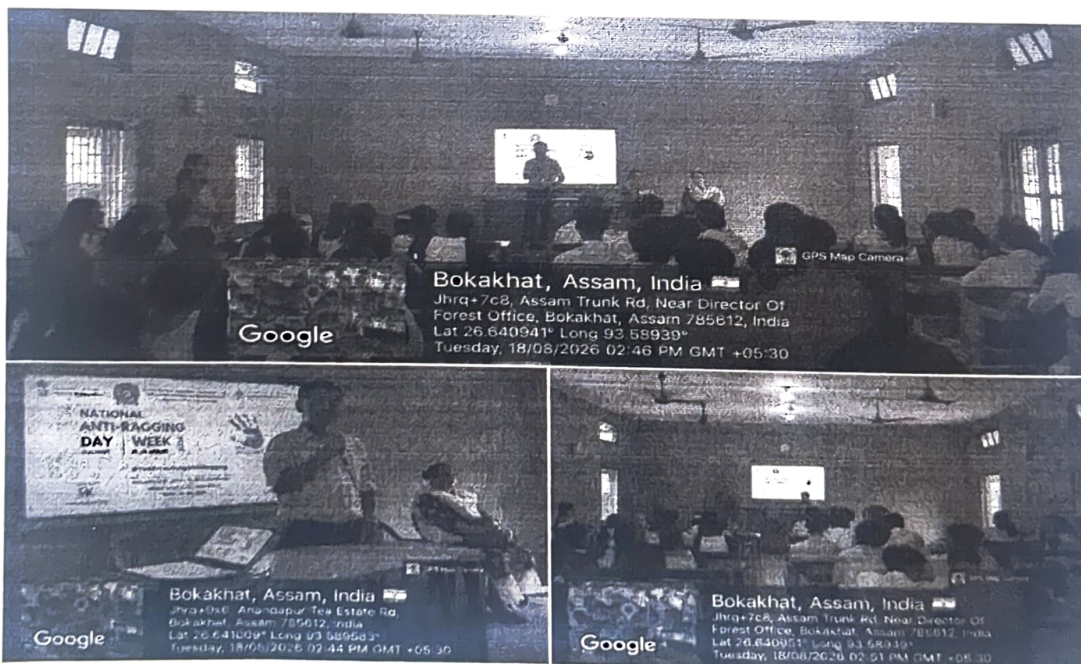
Anti-Ragging Committee

Report on Observation of Anti-Ragging Week

12th August 2026 – 18th August 2026

(Observed as part of National Anti-Ragging Day/Week 2026 | #YaARIYouthAgainstRagging)

Jogananda Deva Satradhikar Goswami College (JDSG College), Bokakhat, observed National Anti-Ragging Day and Anti-Ragging Week from 12th August 2026 to 18th August 2026, as mandated by the University Grants Commission (UGC) and the Ministry of Education, Government of India, under the campaign theme #YaARIYouthAgainstRagging. The observation was organised by the Anti-Ragging Committee of the college with the objective of creating awareness among students about the harmful effects of ragging, the legal provisions in place to prevent it, and the importance of fostering a safe, inclusive, and supportive environment on campus. The week-long observation culminated in an interactive awareness session with eminent resource persons who shared their insights on the subject.

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As part of the observation, an awareness session was held on 18th August 2026 at Digital Classroom-1, JDSG College, anchored by Ms. Papori Borah, Assistant Professor, Department of Commerce, JDSG College. She briefly explained the objectives of the awareness created among students regarding the definition and forms of ragging. She highlighted a discussion on the psychological and social impact of ragging on victims, an explanation of the legal provisions and UGC regulations related to anti-ragging, information shared on reporting mechanisms and the role of the Anti-Ragging Committee/Cell, encouragement to students to foster a culture of mutual respect and support on campus. Faculty members and students of the college attended the session.

Mr. Prasanta Saikia, Vice Principal & Associate Professor, Department of Political Science, JDSG College and Ms. Neebha Noni Baruah, Academic Coordinator & Associate Professor, Department of Economics, JDSG College were the resource persons in the said session. Both resource persons addressed the gathering on the theme of anti-ragging, emphasising the need for a ragging-free campus and the responsibility of every student in maintaining a safe and respectful academic environment. Mrs. Neebha Noni Baruah further elaborated on the legal framework governing anti-ragging measures, including the relevant UGC regulations and provisions under law, and explained the disciplinary and legal consequences that students may face for engaging in ragging. Dr. Monalisa Borgohain, IQAC Coordinator and Head, Department of English, JDSG College, was also present during the session and extended her support and encouragement to the initiative.

The observation of Anti-Ragging Week (12th–18th August 2026) at JDSG College successfully achieved its objective of sensitising students and staff about the importance of maintaining a ragging-free campus. The session concluded with a vote of thanks proposed by Ms. Papori Borah, Assistant Professor, Department of Commerce, JDSG College, followed by a collective resolve to uphold the dignity and safety of all members of the college community.
